Please see below comments for the 2026 QAP/9% round:

- > Going ahead and adding the 15 yr cash flow model as evaluated by SC Housing to the application would be helpful and keep applicants from having to run separate models. I believe this is pretty standard in other states when a DSC requirement exists over the hold period. You're running one, I'm running one, would be nifty if we were looking at the same model.
- > I believe this is a requirement of prelim, but confirming rehabs required to include their site scoring at prelim stage since it becomes a relevant tie breaker at full.
- > Internal medicine should count as healthcare amenity for senior properties since internal medicine is basically GP for adults only.
- > Does minute clinic still count for healthcare(?) I take my kids and myself to minute clinic often in a pinch. I presume it does but wanted to confirm.
- > unclear why dentist was removed as healthcare option, esp. if there isnt a cap on amenity points as there was before. Should add this back as healthcare point option.
